While the Sisters have no fixed source of income and must depend daily on the generosity of others for the funds necessary to manage the home, the atmosphere at St. Augustine Home is calm, warm, and serene. Each Sister, volunteer, employee, and donor contributes time, talent, and treasure out of genuine respect and concern for the elderly.

St. Augustine Home is truly a special place. When one Resident was asked what she liked about living in the home, she exclaimed, "Everything!" She continued, "When you come to live with the Little Sisters, you are not going to an 'old people's home.' You are joining a community... It's like a little family."

For over 130 years, the kindness of donors like you has enabled us to offer a home and quality care to thousands of elderly in Indiana. We are deeply grateful, and we pray daily for all those who assist us in our mission.
